Pre-Camp Swim Checks

Each person who desires to participate in aquatic activities while attending summer camp must pass a swimmer's test. Swim tests are conducted at each of our summer camp facilities as part of the check-in process. To expedite the check-in process and encourage year-round aquatic activities, units are invited to participate in pre-camp swim checks.

For the purposes of summer camp aquatics activities, Old North State Council camps will only honor pre-camp swim tests that were completed at a council sponsored pre-camp swim check or conducted by a unit leader that has completed Swim and Water Rescue Training. The summer camp aquatics director retains the right to re-test anyone at any time.

The Old North State Council will sponsor six pre-camp swim check opportunities. Unit leaders may schedule swim check appointments by calling the council office at 1-800-367-9166 or 336-378-9166. Units must also pre-pay a \$1 per swim test. Once an appointment has been made, checks should be made payable to the Old North State Council and sent to the council office, at PO. Box 29046, Greensboro, NC 27429.

Unit Leaders

The results of the swim check will be marked on the Swim Test Classification Report. The carbonless report form will generate three copies.

The swim test administrator will submit the white copy to the council office, at P.O. Box 29046, Greensboro, NC 27429, by June 1.

The pink copy is for the unit leader. Unit leaders should bring the pink copy with them to summer camp.

The test administrator will keep the yellow copy for his records.

Unit leaders, who have successfully completed Swim and Water Rescue training, are qualified to administer swim checks. They may conduct a swim check for any unit including their own.

Unit leaders will have three opportunities to complete Swim and Water Rescue training before summer camp. The cost is \$20 per person. You may register for the course online at <http://www.bsasonsc.org/eventregistration.html> or submit a paper registration form.
